A PROCLAMATION

PURSUANT to the Public Works Act 1928, I, Sir Arthur Espie Porritt, Baronet, the Governor-General of New Zealand, hereby proclaim and declare that the land described in the Schedules hereto is hereby taken for soil conservation and river control purposes and shall vest in the Hawke's Bay Catchment Board; and I also declare that this Proclamation shall take effect on and after the 18th day of November 1968.

A PROCLAMATION

PURSUANT to section 226 of the Public Works Act 1928, I, Sir Arthur Espie Porritt, Baronet, the Governor-General of New Zealand, hereby proclaim and declare that the land described in the Schedule hereto shall, upon the publication hereof in the *Gazette*, become a road; and that the said road shall be under the control of the Waimea County Council, and shall be maintained by the said Council in like manner as other public highways are controlled and maintained by the said Council.
