PURSUANT to the Public Works Act 1928, I, Sir Arthur Espie Porritt, Baronet, the Governor-General of New Zealand, hereby proclaim and declare that the land described in the First Schedule hereto is hereby taken for road, and that the land described in the Second Schedule hereto is hereby taken for recreation ground and shall vest in the Chairman, Councillors, and Inhabitants of the County of Waitemata from the date hereinafter mentioned; and I also declare that this Proclamation shall take effect on and after the 26th day of February 1968.
