Bulk Water Supply Loan No. 19, 1968, \$1,250,000—First Issue, \$50,000

PURSUANT to the Local Authorities Loans Act 1956 and the Auckland Regional Authority Act 1963, the Auckland Regional Authority has resolved to the following effect:

That, for the purpose of providing the annual charges on a loan of \$50,000 authorised to be raised under the above-mentioned Acts for the purposes of and incidental to the continued development of the Hunua Catchments, the Auckland Regional Authority hereby makes a special rate of the several amounts in the dollar set out in the fourth column of the Schedule attached hereto on the rateable values set against such amounts respectively in the third column of such Schedule of all rateable property of the local authorities listed in the first column of such Schedule and set out against such amounts and rateable values respectively; and that the special rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of the loan, which shall be 35 years from 15 January 1969.

RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATES

Reserves Loan No. 4, 1968, \$76,600

PURSUANT to the Local Authorities Loans Act 1956 and the Auckland Regional Authority Act 1963, the Auckland Regional Authority has resolved to the following effect:

That, for the purpose of providing the annual charges on a loan of \$76,600 authorised to be raised under the above-mentioned Acts for the purposes of and incidental to the developing of regional reserves, the Auckland Regional Authority hereby makes a special rate of the several amounts in the dollar set out in the fourth column of the Schedule attached hereto on the rateable values set against such amounts respectively in the third column of such Schedule of all rateable property of the local authorities listed in the first column of such Schedule and set out against such amounts and rateable values respectively; and that the special rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of the loan, which shall, at the lender's option, be for periods of 6, 10, and 20 years from 24 March 1969 or until the loan is fully paid off.
