Reservation of Land and Vesting in the Kawerau Borough

S. 7273: thence south-easterly to and along that boundary point in line with the south-western boundary of part Lot 3, D.P. S. 7273; thence south-easterly to and along that boundary to its southernmost point; thence north-easterly along the south-eastern boundaries of part Lot 3, aforesaid, Lot 2, D.P. Station 31, Paeroa, in Block V, Paeroa Survey District, and Trig. Station 2120, Tawhiwhau, in Block XIV, Galatea Survey District; thence south-easterly along that right line to the production of a right line between Trig.
