Table with columns: Station, Height of Station Above M.S.L., Air Temperatures in Degrees (Fahrenheit) (Means of A and B, Mean of A and B, Difference From Normal, Absolute Maximum and Minimum), Rainfall in Inches (Total Fall, No. of Rain Days, Difference From Normal, Maximum Fall), Bright Sunshine (Hrs.). Rows list various stations like Kaikoura, Balmoral, Hermitage, Mt. Cook, etc., down to Lake Vanda, Antarctica.

LATE RETURNS

Summary table for late returns for Kinleith, February 1969 and Golden Downs, Feb. 1969, with columns for temperature, rainfall, and sunshine data.

The "normal" refers to the present site of the instruments. The standard periods for normals are: for temperature 1931-60, for rainfall 1921-50, and for sunshine 1935-60. No normals are available for stations with only short records.

*The sunshine recorder is not located at the station but is in the near vicinity.
