ORDER

1. (1) This order may be cited as the Opotiki Hydatids Control District Order 1969.

(2) This order shall come into force on the day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.

2. The areas comprising the County and Borough of Opotiki are hereby declared a hydatids control district to be called the Opotiki Hydatids Control District.

3. The Opotiki County Council is hereby appointed the Hydatids Control Authority for that district.
