

*Further Extending the Duration of Licences Authorising the Tauranga Electric Power Board to Use Electric Lines within the Tauranga Electric Power District and Outer Area of Such District*

PURSUANT to the Electricity Act 1968, the Minister of Electricity hereby amends the Orders in Council specified in the Schedule hereto, authorising the Tauranga Electric Power Board to use electric lines, by further extending the duration of the said Orders in Council until the 20th day of October 1969; the duration of the said Orders in Council having been extended until the 20th day of October 1968 by an Order in Council dated the 15th day of July 1968 and appearing in the *Gazette* on the 25th day of the same month, at page 1235, and the duration of the said Orders in Council having been further extended until the 20th day of April 1969 by an Order in Council dated the 21st day of October 1968 and appearing in the *Gazette* on the 31st day of the same month, at page 2001.

*The Newlands and Paparangi Secondary Schools Notice 1969*

PURSUANT to section 57 of the Education Act 1964 as amended by section 9 of the Education Amendment Act 1968, the Minister of Education hereby gives notice as follows.

**NOTICE**

1. This notice may be cited as the Newlands and Paparangi Secondary Schools Notice 1969.

2. The Board of Governors for the control of the secondary school to serve Newlands and Paparangi shall be constituted as follows:

- One member appointed by the Wellington Education Board;
- One member appointed by the Wellington City Corporation;
- One member appointed by the Council of the Victoria University of Wellington;
- Six members elected by the parents of the pupils attending the school:

Provided that, until the school is opened and the election of members by the parents of the pupils attending the school is held, the Minister of Education may appoint up to six persons to be members of the Board and to hold office until the members elected by the parents of the pupils assume office;

- One member co-opted by the Board of Governors itself, if and when it thinks fit.
