3. To authorise the society to lend the whole or part of the proceeds of the sale of those premises to the Palmerston North Returned Services' Association (Incorporated) on the security of a second mortgage.

4. To provide for the dissolution of the society as from the 1st day of January 1990 and the vesting of all real and personal property then held by the society in the Palmerston North Returned Services' Association (Incorporated), subject to that association holding the said property for a period of 20 years the profession when the said property for a period in paragraph thereafter upon trust for the purpose mentioned in paragraph
