*National Roads Board—Notice Declaring State Highway to be a Limited Access Road*

It is notified that the National Roads Board, by resolution dated 20 August 1969, and pursuant to section 4 of the Public Works Amendment Act 1963, hereby declares the south-western half road width of No. 72 State Highway (Woodend-Winchester) from its junction with S.H. 1 at Woodend to its junction with Woodend Road, and the full road width of No. 72 State Highway (Woodend-Winchester) from its junction with Woodend Road to a point 41 chains west of its junction with Golf Links Road, as more particularly shown on sheet 1 of plan M.O.W. 15543 and the accompanying Schedule, held in the office of the resident engineer, Ministry of Works, Christchurch, and there available for public inspection, to be a limited access road.
