IN pursuance of the powers conferred upon the Price Tribunal by the Control of Prices Act 1947, the Price Tribunal hereby makes the following price order:

1. This order may be cited as Price Order No. 2116 and shall be read together with, and deemed part of, Price Order No. 2114\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal order).

2. This order shall come into force on the 12th day of September 1969.

3. The principal order is hereby amended by revoking clause 4 thereof and substituting the following:

"This order shall apply to all sales of herbicides, insecticides, and acaricides specified in such Schedule as may be published in the *Gazette* from time to time by the Minister of Agriculture pursuant to the Department of Agriculture Act 1953 and the Agricultural Chemicals Act 1959; but shall not apply to any herbicide, insecticide, or acaricide packed in a container holding less than 1 gallon of liquid or less than 4 lb by weight of solid, unless the herbicide, insecticide, or acaricide is a restricted poison as so declared by regulation 4 of the Poisons Regulations 1964."
