That, for the purpose of providing the annual charges on a loan of \$30,000 authorised to be raised by the Kaikoura County Council under the above-mentioned Act for the purpose of providing staff housing, the said Kaikoura County Council hereby makes a special rate of decimal 02c in the dollar upon the rateable value, on the basis of the capital value, of all rateable property comprised in the whole of the County of Kaikoura; and that the special rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of the loan, being a period of twenty (20) years, or until the loan is fully paid off.
