NOTICE OF SPECIAL ORDER

Rural Housing Loan 1969—\$18,000

IN pursuance and in exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Bodies Loans Act 1956 and of all other powers and authorities enabling it in that behalf, the Waipukurau County Council hereby resolves as follows:

"That, for the purposes of providing the annual charges on a loan of \$18,000 authorised to be raised by the Waipukurau County Council under the above-mentioned Act for the purpose of rural housing, the said Waipukurau County Council hereby makes and levies a special rate of decimal nought two five nine six four (.025964) cents in the dollar upon the rateable property in the County of Waipukurau; and that the special rate be an annually recurring rate during the currency of the loan and shall be payable half-yearly on the 1st day of June and the 1st day of December in each and every year during the currency of the loan, being a period of 25 years, or until the loan is fully paid off."

- Hutt County Council, Wellington;
- Lower Hutt City Council, Lower Hutt;
- Petone Borough Council, Petone;
- Porirua City Council, Porirua;
- Tawa Borough Council, Tawa;
- Upper Hutt City Council, Upper Hutt; and
- Wellington City Council, Wellington.

Pursuant to section 18 of the Local Government Commission Act 1967, written objections to the provisional area scheme, stating the grounds thereof, may be lodged with the Commission, by any person or body interested, not later than 3 months after the first public notification of the scheme. Should no objections be lodged during that period, the Local Government Commission may approve the provisional area scheme as a final area scheme.
