thence along a right line across Pleasant Road to and along the north-western boundaries of Lots 1 to 8 inclusive, D.P. 33070, Lots 1 to 12 inclusive, D.P. 38865, Lots 1 to 5 inclusive, D.P. 40846, Lot 1, D.P. 45863, and Lot 2, D.P. 48735, to its northernmost corner; thence easterly generally along the north-eastern boundary of Lot 2, D.P. 48735, and continuing along the north-eastern boundary of Allotment 138, Waikomiti Parish, along a right line across Titirangi Road to and along the north-eastern boundaries of Lot 9, D.P. 23375 (plantation reserve), Lots 5 and 7, D.P. 39449, along a right line across West Lynn Road to and along the north-eastern boundaries of Lots 1 and 3, D.P. 10388, the south-eastern boundaries of Lots 6 and 7, D.P. 40481, to and along the south-western side of Parker Avenue to a point in line with the middle line of Hutchinson Avenue;
