In the matter of the Public Works Act 1928 and its amendments, public notice is hereby given that the Franklin County Council proposes under the provisions of the above-mentioned Act: *firstly*, to complete the execution of certain public works, namely, the provision of road; and, for the purpose of such public works, the lands described in the First Schedule hereto are required to be taken; *secondly*, to stop, pursuant to the provisions of section 148 of the Public Works Act 1928, those pieces of road described in the Second Schedule hereto; and *thirdly*, to deal with the "severances" described in the Third Schedule hereto.
