A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS the General Assembly of New Zealand stands prorogued to the 13th day of November 1969, and I have thought fit to dissolve it:

Now, therefore, pursuant to the New Zealand Constitution Act 1852, I, Sir Arthur Espie Porritt, Baronet, the Governor-General of New Zealand, hereby dissolve the General Assembly as from the date hereof.
