Pursuant to the Local Authorities Loans Act 1956, the Henderson Borough Council hereby resolves as follows:

"That, for the purpose of providing the annual charges on a loan of \$6,400 authorised to be raised by the Henderson Borough Council under the above-mentioned Act for the purpose of repaying on maturity that portion of the Development Loan 1958, of \$100,000, which matures on the 22nd day of October 1969, the said Henderson Borough Council hereby makes a special rate of decimal nought one eight cents in the dollar (.018c in the \$1) on the rateable unimproved value of all rateable property in the Borough of Henderson; that such special rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of the loan and be payable yearly on the 1st day of June in each and every year during the currency of the loan, being a period of 10 years, or until the loan is fully paid off; and that such special rate is hereby permanently appropriated and pledged as security for the purpose of securing the said loan of \$6,400 and interest thereon at a rate not exceeding five and three-quarters percent (5¾%) per annum."
