RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE

Pensioner Housing Supplementary Loan 1969—\$1,745.00

THAT, pursuant to the Local Authorities Loans Act 1956, the Carterton Borough Council hereby resolves as follows:

That, for the purpose of providing annual charges on a supplementary loan of \$1,745 authorised to be raised by the Carterton Borough Council under the above-mentioned Act for the erection of pensioner housing, the said Carterton Borough Council hereby makes a special rate of 0.0000714 of \$1 upon the rateable value of all rateable property in the Borough of Carterton; and that the said special rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of the loan and be payable half-yearly on the 1st day of December and the 1st day of June of each and every year during the currency of the loan, being a period of 40 years or until the loan is fully paid off.

It is not proposed to collect the special rate, as the loan charges will be met out of rental of the cottages.
