NOTICE OF PROPOSAL TO STOP PIECES OF ROAD

WAIMEA ELECTRIC POWER BOARD

RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE

PURSUANT to the Local Authorities Loans Act 1956, the Waimea Electric Power Board hereby resolves as follows:

That, for the purpose of providing the annual charges on a loan of \$250,000, known as Reticulation Loan (No. 14) 1969, authorised to be raised by the Waimea Electric Power Board under the above-mentioned Act for the purpose of constructing electrical works and line extensions, the said Waimea Electric Power Board hereby makes a special rate of decimal nought two five cents (.025c) in the dollar upon the rateable value (on the basis of the capital value) of all rateable property of the Waimea Electric Power District; and that the special rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of the loan and be payable yearly on the 1st day of April in each and every year during the currency of the loan, being a period of 20 years, or until the loan is fully paid off.
