

Exempting Certain Companies From the Overseas Take-overs Regulations 1964

PURSUANT to the Overseas Take-overs Regulations 1964*, the Minister of Finance hereby exempts from all the requirements of those regulations any offeror that is a company within the meaning of the Companies Act 1955, and is an overseas person within the meaning of paragraph (c) of the definition of that term in regulation 2 (1) of those regulations, but which would not be an overseas person if the shares held in the company by any of the life insurance offices mentioned in the Schedule hereto were held by persons who are not overseas persons.
