6. Where the Board makes bylaws under section 165 of the Harbours Act 1950 for the control of foreshore, then the Board shall first obtain the written consent of the Auckland Harbour Board to the proposed bylaws before submitting them to the Minister of Marine in accordance with subsection 9 of the said section.

7. The powers, functions, duties, and authorities conferred on the Board by this order may be at any time resumed by the Governor-General without payment or any compensation whatever, on giving to the Board at least 6 months notice in writing. Any such notice shall be sufficient if given by the Minister and delivered at or posted to the Board at its public office.
