on 1 August 1970; and those portions of the Streets and Drainage Loan 1959, \$33,000; the Streets Reconstruction Loan No. 9, 1960—\$60,000; the Streets Reconstruction Loan No. 7, 1959—\$98,700; and the Streets Reconstruction Loan No. 6, 1959—\$65,000 which mature on 1 December 1970, the said Lower Hult City Council hereby makes and levies a special rate of 0.150 of a cent in the dollar on the rateable value (on the basis of the annual value) on all rateable property in the City of Lower Hutt; and that such special rate shall be an annually recurring rate during the currency of such loan and be payable yearly on or about the 1st day of August in each and every year during the currency of such loan, being a period of 10 years, or until such time as the loan is paid off."
