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Revoking Part of a Proclamation Declaring Areas in the Whangarei Acclimatisation District to be Wildlife Refuges (Mair Park and Adjoining Areas)

ARTHUR PORRITT, Governor-General A PROCLAMATION

PURSUANT to section 14 of the Wildlife Act 1953, I, Sir Arthur Espie Porritt, Baronet, the Governor-General of New Zealand, hereby revoke that part of the Proclamation issued on the 14th day of February 1958* declaring the area of land in the Whangarei Acclimatisation District described in the Schedule hereto to be a wildlife refuge for the purposes of the Wildlife Act 1953.

SCHEDULE

MAIR Park and adjoining areas-

All that area of 16 acres and 36.7 perches, more or less, being that part of Allotment 2, Parish of Whangarei, comprised in certificate of title, Volume 526, folio 19 (limited as to parcels and title), and Lot 3, D.P. 26522, Lot 1, D.P. 28904, and Lots 1 and 3, D.P. 29387, all being parts of the said Allotment 2, situated in Block IX, Whangarei Survey District.

As the same is shown on plan marked I.A. 52/369, deposited in the Head Office, Department of Internal Affairs, Wellington, and thereon edged red.
