INANGAHUA COUNTY COUNCIL

RESOLUTIONS MAKING SPECIAL RATES

At a special meeting of the Inangahua County Council, held on the 3rd day of March 1970, the following resolutions were made:

1. That a special rate of 0.005c in the dollar, on the basis of the capital value, on all rateable property within the County of Inangahua be levied as security for the Reefton Water Supply Repayment Loan 1969, \$13,700; such rate to be payable on the 1st day of April in each and every year for a period of 10 years, or until the loan is fully paid.

2. That a special rate of 0.0644c in the dollar, on the basis of the capital value, on all rateable property within the Reefton Township Special Rating Area be levied as security for the Reefton Water Supply Loan, \$6,300; such rate to be payable on the 1st day of April in each and every year for a period of 10 years, or until the loan is fully paid.
