Land Set Apart as Provisional State Forest Declared to be Subject to the Land Act 1948

ARTHUR PORRITT, Governor-General A PROCLAMATION

PURSUANT to subsection (2) of section 19 of the Forests Act 1949, I, Sir Arthur Espie Porritt, Baronet, the Governor-General of New Zealand, acting on the joint recommendation of the Minister of Lands and of the Minister of Forests, hereby proclaim and declare that the land described in the Schedule hereto, being part of provisional State forest reserve No. 1706, set apart by Proclamation dated the 3rd day of May 1921, and published in *Gazette*, 12 May 1921, Volume II, p. 1117, is required for settlement purposes; and, in accordance with the provisions of the said Act, such land shall, from and after the day of the gazetting hereof, cease to be provisional State forest land and shall become Crown land, available for sale, lease. reservation, or other disposition under the provisions of lease, reservation, or other disposition under the provisions of the Land Act 1948.
