(4) Such number of Vice-Presidents as seem fit may be

elected by the general membership present at the annual general meeting from those members elected to the Council by the various wards. The Vice-Presidents shall retire as Vice-Presidents at the next

Presidents shall retire as Vice-Presidents at the next annual general meeting held after their election, but shall be eligible for re-election.

(5) At each annual general meeting the one-half of the number of councillors who have been longest on the Council without being re-elected shall retire but shall be eligible for re-election. The vacancies thus created shall be filled by ballot as provided in rule 9 hereof. As between two or more councillors who have been in office an equal length of time, the member or members to retire shall in default of agreement between them be determined by lot determined by lot.

(6) Vacancies on the Council caused by the retirement of members shall be filled from such members as will maintain the ward representation as set out in subclause

(2) of this rule.

(7) Where any member of the Council ceases to have his permanent and principal or only place of residence within the district, he shall cease to be a member of the Council as from the commencement of the next annual general meeting.

general meeting.

(8) In the event of any member of the Council dying, resigning, or vacating his office, the Council may appoint to the vacancy any member of the society who is available and eligible. Every such appointee shall hold office for the balance of the term of his predecessor.

(9) A member of the Council shall vacate his office if he has absented himself from three consecutive meetings of the Council without leave of absence having been granted by the Council.

(10) An elected member or a member appointed to fill a vacancy under subclause (8) of this rule shall vacate his office if he ceases to be a member of the society.
