The foregoing special order was passed at a special meeting of the Auckland Regional Authority, convened for that purpose and held on 16 March 1970, and confirmed at an ordinary meeting of the said Authority, held on 27 April 1970, having meantime been advertised in the *Auckland Star* on 21 March and 4 April 1970.

#### NOTICE OF APPLICATION FOR APPROVAL OF SCHEME
