PURSUANT to the Transport Act 1962, the Minister of Transport hereby gives the following notice.

## NOTICE

1. This notice may be cited as the Traffic (Rotorua City and Rotorua County) Notice No. 1, 1970.

2. The roads specified in the First Schedule hereto are hereby excluded from the limitation as to speed imposed by section 52 of the Transport Act 1962.

3. The roads specified in the Second Schedule hereto are hereby declared to be 40-miles-per-hour speed limit areas for the purposes of regulation 27A of the Traffic Regulations 1956\*.

4. The notice under section 52 of the Transport Act 1962, dated the 19th day of August 1965†, which relates to Rotorua City, is hereby revoked.

## FIRST SCHEDULE

SITUATED within Rotorua City:

No. 5 State Highway (Tirau-Napier via Rotorua and Taupo) (from the northern boundary of Rotorua City to a point 1 chain measured north-westerly generally along the said highway from Kawaha Point Road; and from the southern boundary of Rotorua City to a point 23 chains measured north-easterly generally along the said highway from Old Taupo Road).
