

the north-eastern boundary of Section 1, Block XIV, Maraekakaho Survey District, to the northernmost corner of that section, along a right line to a point in the middle of the Mangaonuku Stream in line with the north-western boundary of Section 1, Block X, Maraekakaho Survey District, then up the middle of that stream to a point in line with the original northern boundary of Block 3, Gwavas Crown Grant District, in Block IV, Wakarara Survey District, to and along that boundary to Kereru Road, along a right line to and again along that said northern boundary and south-westerly and southerly along the north-western boundaries of the said Block 3, and the north-western and western boundaries of Blocks 1, 5, and again Block 1, all of Gwavas Crown Grant District, and the production of the last-mentioned boundary to the middle of the Mangamauku Stream; thence north-westerly up the middle of that stream to a point in line with the north-eastern boundary of Section 1, Block XI, Wakarara Survey District, to and along that boundary to the northernmost corner of the said Section 1; thence westerly along a right line to the confluence of the Makaroro River and the Makaroro Stream in Block IX, Wakarara Survey District, and north-westerly along a right line to Trig. Station 30 (Aorangi) in Block XI, Pukeokahu Survey District, Wellington Land District, to its intersection with the western boundary of Block I, Wakarara Survey District; thence northerly generally along that boundary and the western boundary of Block XVIII, Ngaruroro Survey District, to Trig. Station V; thence north-easterly along a right line to a point in the middle of the Taruarau River in line with the south-western boundary of Block 78, Maraekakaho Crown Grant District, in Block II, Ngaruroro Survey District; thence easterly generally down the middle of that river to and northerly generally up the middle of the Ngaruroro River to the point of commencement; excluding therefrom the City of Hastings, hereinbefore described, the City of Napier, as described in *New Zealand Gazette*, 1968, page 1534, and the Borough of Havelock North, as described in *New Zealand Gazette*, 1968, page 101.

BOUNDARIES OF HERETAUNGA RIDING OF COUNTY OF HAWKE'S BAY

ALL that area in the Hawke's Bay Land District, Hawke's Bay County, bounded by a line commencing at a point in the middle of the Ngaruroro River at its confluence with the old bed of the Ngaruroro River (Karamu Creek) in Block XIII, Heretaunga Survey District, and proceeding southerly to and up the middle of that old river bed to and up the middle of the Awanui Stream to the middle of Te Aute Road in Block III, Te Mata Survey District; thence south-westerly along the middle of that road to and along the middle of No. 2 National State Highway to its intersection with the middle of Farndon-Pakipaki Road; thence north-westerly generally along the middle of that road to and along the middle of Bridge Pa-Pakipaki Road to and along the middle of Maraekakaho Road to a point in line with the north-eastern boundary of Lot 18, D.P. 10360; thence north-westerly to and along that boundary and the north-eastern boundaries of Lot 2, D.P. 1876, the aforesaid Lot 18, and Lots 16 and 13, D.P. 10360, part Lot 1, D.P. 2142, Lot 1, D.P. 5164, Lots 5 and 1, D.P. 9765, and Lots 5 and 4, D.P. 1795, and the production of the last-mentioned boundary to the middle of No. 50 Provincial State Highway; thence north-easterly along the middle of that highway to a point in line with the northern boundary of Ngatarawa No. 1 Block; thence westerly to and along that boundary and the northern boundary of Section 5, Block XIII, Heretaunga Survey District, and its production to the middle of the Ngaruroro River; thence down the middle of that river to the point of commencement; excluding therefrom the City of Hastings, hereinbefore described.
