Land Taken for Hospital Purposes in Block VI, Coromandel Survey District, Coromandel County

Sir Herbert Richard Churton Wild, the Administrator of the Government of New Zealand, hereby proclaim and declare that the land described in the Schedule hereto is hereby taken for hospital purposes and shall vest in the Thames Hospital Board as from the date hereinafter mentioned; and I also declare that this Proclamation shall take effect on and after the 8th day of June 1970.
