Additional Loan 1970, of \$150,000

"Pursuant to the Local Authorities Loans Act 1956 the Wellington City Council hereby resolves as follows:

Wellington City Council hereby resolves as follows: "That for the purpose of providing the annual charges on a loan of one hundred and fifty thousand dollars (\$150,000) to be known as Housing (Newtown Park Stage II) Additional Loan 1970, of \$150,000, authorised to be raised by the Wellington City Council under the above-mentioned Act for the purpose of meeting the additional costs of Newtown Park Flats Stage II, the Wellington City Council hereby makes a special rate of decimal nought nought six five of a cent (.0065c) in the dollar on the rateable value (on the basis of the unimproved value) of all rateable property within the whole of the City of Wellington; and that the said special rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of such loan and shall be payable yearly on the 1st day of April in each year during the currency of the said loan, being a period of forty (40) years or until the loan is fully paid off."
