Land and an Easement Over Land Taken for the Purposes of and Incidental to the Provision of Main Sewerage Works for the Auckland Metropolitan Drainage District in Block IV, Otahuhu Survey District and the Borough of Howick

RICHARD WILD, Administrator of the Government A PROCLAMATION

PURSUANT to the Public Works Act 1928, I, the Right Hon. Sir Herbert Richard Churton Wild, the Administrator of the Government of New Zealand, hereby proclaim and declare that the land described in the First Schedule hereto is hereby taken for the purposes of and incidental to the provision of main sewerage works for the Auckland Metro-politan Drainage District and shall vest in the Auckland Regional Authority as from the date hereinafter mentioned; Regional Authority as from the date hereinafter mentioned; and I also proclaim and declare that an easement of right of way is hereby taken for the purposes of and incidental to the provision of main sewerage works for the Auckland Metropolitan Drainage District over the land described in the Second Schedule hereto vesting in the Auckland Regional Authority as from the date hereinafter mentioned the full, free, uninterrupted, and unrestricted right, liberty, and privilege for the Authority, its servants, tenants, agents, workmen, licensees, and invitees at all times to go, pass, and repass with or without motor and other vehicles, horses, plant, machinery, and vehicles of any kind over and along the said land described in the Second Schedule; and I also declare that this Proclamation shall take effect from and after the 13th day of July 1970.

FIRST SCHEDULE
