

Y, Mount Malvern, on the boundary between Blocks XV and XVI, Blue Mountain Survey District; thence generally south-westerly along the summit of the south-eastern water shed of the Awatere River passing through Mount McRae, Tapuae-nuku, Mount Union, St. Bernard, Tone Saddle, Turks Head to Trig. Station Ref. A in Block VII, Barefell Survey District; thence generally northerly and north-easterly along the summit of the western and north-western water sheds of the Awatere River passing through Barefell Pass, Trig. Barefell, Wards Pass, Saxton Pass, Murphy, Shingle Peak, Pinnacle, Ferny Gair, Blairich, and Trig.
