Rural Housing Loan 1970, \$21,000

THE following resolution was duly passed at a meeting of the Waimairi County Council held on 17 September, 1970:

"Pursuant to the Local Authorities Loans Act 1956, the Waimairi County Council hereby resolves as follows:

"That, for the purpose of providing the annual charges on a loan of \$21,000 authorised to be raised by the Waimairi County Council under the above-mentioned Act, for making advances to farmers in terms of the Rural Housing Act 1939, the Waimairi County Council makes a special rate of 0.000977c (cents) in the \$ (dollar) upon the rateable value on the basis of capital value of all rateable property in the County of Waimairi, and that the special rate shall be an annually recurring rate during the currency of the loan, and be payable yearly on the 1st day of April in each and every year during the currency of the loan, being a period of 25 years, or until the loan is fully paid off."
