IN THE MATTER of Part III of the Charitable Trusts Act and IN THE MATTER of the trusts contained in a certain deed of trust dated the 29th day of March 1941, constituting the LORD RUTHERFORD MEMORIAL RESEARCH FELLOWSHIP and affecting the University of Canterbury:

NOTICE is hereby given, pursuant to section 36 of the Charitable Trusts Act 1957, that the Trustees under the above-mentioned deed of trust have applied to the Supreme Court at Christchurch for approval to a scheme for the amendment of the regulations contained in the said deed of trust relating to the administration of the Lord Rutherford Memorial Research Fellowship. The scheme provides that the annual value of the fellowship shall be one thousand five hundred dollars (\$1,500), and that the fellowship shall normally be awarded in every fourth year. The scheme also provides for amendments to the regulations contained in the said deed relating to the election of a Fellow and the tenure of the fellowship.
