PURSUANT to section 14 of the Wildlife Act 1953, I, Sir Arthur Espie Porritt, Baronet, the Governor-General of New Zealand, hereby revoke the Proclamation issued on the 20th day of April 1953*, declaring an area of land in the Cobden Survey District, in the West Coast Acclimatisation District, to be a sanctuary for the purposes of the Animals Protection and Game Act 1921-22.
