

*Notice of Intention to Vary Hours for Sale of Liquor at Licensed Premises: Porirua District Licensing Trust*

PURSUANT to subsection (10) of section 34B of the Licensing Trusts Act 1949, as inserted by section 3 (1) of the Licensing Trusts Amendment Act 1967, I, Eric Alderson Missen, Secretary for Justice, hereby give notice that the Porirua District Licensing Trust at a meeting on 27 August 1970, passed the following resolution:
