#### BOUNDARIES OF TANEATUA RIDING OF COUNTY OF WHAKATANE

ALL that area in the South Auckland Land District, Whakatane County, commencing at a point on the left bank of the Whakatane River in Block I, Whakatane Survey District, being the easternmost corner of Lot 2, D.P. 13465, and proceeding south-easterly along a right line between that corner and the north-western corner of Lot 1, D.P. 18662, to the boundary of the Borough of Whakatane in the middle of the Whakatane River; thence south-westerly, south-easterly, and north-easterly generally along that borough boundary as hereinbefore described, to the south-western side of the Whakatane-Kutarere Road; thence south-easterly generally along the generally south-western sides of that road, Wainui Stock Road, and Burma Road to the eastern boundary of Lot 3, D.P. 24302; thence southerly along that boundary and the eastern boundary of part Lot 4, D.P. 10439, to the southern boundary of that lot; thence westerly along that boundary to the eastern boundary of Allotment 461, Waimana Parish; thence southerly along that boundary to the northern side of a public road; thence southerly along a right line to the south-eastern corner of Allotment 472, Waimana Parish, as shown on S.O. Plan 36426; thence easterly and southerly along the northern and eastern boundaries of Allotment 455, Waimana Parish, as shown on S.O. Plan 35258, to the north-eastern side of Stanley Road; thence south-easterly along that roadside to a point in line with the northern boundary of part Allotment 337, Waimana Parish; thence to and along that boundary and the northern boundary of Allotment 446 and again along the northern boundary of part Allotment 337, aforesaid, to the eastern side of No. 2 State Highway; thence southerly along that eastern side to a point in line with the southern boundary of Allotment 379, Waimana Parish; thence to and along that boundary, along a right line to and along the generally northern boundaries of Allotment 345 to the western boundary of that allotment; thence along that boundary and the western boundaries of Allotment 327, an area of Crown land, and Allotments 355 and 340, all of Waimana Parish, and along the western boundary of Lot 2, D.P. S. 11223, to the northern boundary of part Ruatoki 1B 2U 3; thence westerly along that boundary, crossing, along right lines, all intervening public roads, along the northern boundary of part Ruatoki 1B 2A, and along a right line to and along the northern boundary of part Ruatoki 1B 2C 2 to the right bank of the Whakatane River in Block II, Whakatane Survey District; thence westerly along a right line to and along the northern boundaries of Ruatoki 1B 2J 2 and parts 1B 2H, 1B 2B 3, and 1B 2I 3, along a right line to and again along the last-mentioned boundary and the northern boundaries of Ruatoki part 1B 2U 11, 1B 2U 12, 1B 2U 7, 1B 2U 6, and 2B 1, along a right line to and along the northern boundaries of Ruatoki 2B 2, along a right line to and along the last-mentioned boundary and the northern boundary of Ruatoki 2B 11 to the south-western corner of Allotment 41B 10b, Rangitaiki Parish, in Block IV, Rangitaiki Lower Survey District; thence northerly along the western boundaries of Allotments 41B 10b, 41A 9d, and 33L, Rangitaiki Parish, to the northern boundary of Allotment 33L, aforesaid; thence along that boundary, along a right line to and again along that northern boundary, along another right line to and again along that northern boundary to the western side of Fosters Road; thence easterly along a right line to and along the northern boundaries of Allotment 42, Rangitaiki Parish, Lot 1, D.P. 11736, and Lots 1 and 2, D.P. 10785, to the left bank of the Whakatane River; thence northerly generally along that bank to the point of commencement.

#### BOUNDARIES OF GALATEA RIDING OF COUNTY OF WHAKATANE

ALL that area in the South Auckland Land District, Whakatane County, bounded by a line commencing at the southernmost corner of part Allotment 63, Matata Parish (provisional State forest, *Gazette*, 1920, p. 2107), in Block XV, Rotoma Survey District, and proceeding easterly along the northern boundary of Te Hachaenga No. 4 and its production to and along the northern boundary of part Kawerau B. to and along the left bank of the Tarawera River to the western boundary of Block XIII, Rangitaiki Upper Survey District; thence along a right line to the south-western corner of Allotment 59B 2, Matata Parish, as shown on M.L. 12396; thence along the southern boundaries of that allotment and Allotment 59B 1 (M.L. 12396) to and along the northern boundary of part Matahina A. 1d, along a right line to and along the northern boundaries of another part A. 1d and another part A. 1d to the left bank of the Rangitaiki River; thence southerly generally along that bank to the southern boundary of Block XIV, Rangitaiki Lower

Survey District; thence easterly generally along that boundary, the southern boundary of Block XV, Rangitaiki Lower Survey District, the western and south-eastern boundaries of Oputea Block and the southern boundary of Block XV, aforesaid, to its easternmost point; thence southerly generally along the western boundaries of Blocks IV, VIII, XII, and XVI, Galatea Survey District, the northern and western boundaries of Block III, and the western boundaries of Blocks VII, XI, and XV, Ahikereru Survey District, and the western boundary of Block III, Tuwatawata Survey District, to the boundary of Whakatane County, as hereinbefore described; thence south-westerly generally and northerly along that county boundary to the point of commencement; excluding therefrom the Borough of Murupara, as hereinbefore described.

#### BOUNDARIES OF MATATA RIDING OF COUNTY OF WHAKATANE

ALL that area in the South Auckland Land District, Whakatane County, bounded by a line commencing at the southernmost corner of part Allotment 63, Matata Parish (provisional State forest, *Gazette*, 1920, p. 2107), in Block XV, Rotoma Survey District, being a point on the western boundary of Whakatane County, and proceeding northerly and south-easterly along that boundary, as hereinbefore described, to the left bank of the Tarawera River; thence southerly generally along that bank to a point in line with the northern boundary of Kawerau Borough; thence along a right line to the north-western corner of that borough; thence south-westerly and southerly generally along the north-western and western boundaries of that borough, as hereinbefore described, to the left bank of the Tarawera River; thence along the northern boundary of part Kawerau B. and its production to and along the northern boundary of Te Hachaenga No. 4 to the point of commencement.
