A PROCLAMATION

*Defining the Middle Line of a Road in Blocks XI, XIV, and XV, Ikitara Survey District, Wanganui County, viz, a Deviation of the Whangaehu-Turakina Section of the Hamilton-Woodville via New Plymouth No. 3 State Highway*

A PROCLAMATION

PURSUANT to the Public Works Act 1928, I, Sir Arthur Espie Porritt, Baronet, the Governor-General of New Zealand, hereby proclaim and declare that the middle line of a road desired to be constructed over Blocks XI, XIV and XV, Ikitara Survey District, viz, a deviation of the Whangaehu-Turakina section of the Hamilton-Woodville via New Plymouth No. 3 State Highway, shall be that defined and set forth in the Schedule hereto; and I also declare that this Proclamation shall affect only the lands situated within the limits of the area bounded by broken black lines shown on the plan marked M.O.W. 24647 referred to in the Schedule hereto.

SCHEDULE

WELLINGTON LAND DISTRICT
