Tubing, translucent, surgical, for pressure drainage, transfusion and stethoscopic purposes. Sticks, applicator, for use as surgical swab applicators. Dental articulating paper. Paper, indicator, for use in autoclaves. Bitewing holders specially designed to hold X-ray films in the mouth. Dental floss. Umbilical sterile tape. Thread, braided, surgical suture, non-absorbable. Applicators, surgical, tipped with wadding, 6" or more in length. Strips of textile or metal impregnated with abrasive for dental use; arbour bands, suited for the fine grinding of dentures. Beads, specially suited for patient identification in hospitals. Casting machines. Hypodermic needle clippers specially suited for destroying disposable needles. Welding machines, capacitor type, for use in making orthodontic appliances. Furnaces, dental porcelain, suited for use in making artificial tooth crowns.
