Consent to the Generation of Electricity by James Macaulay and Ellen Daphne Macaulay by the Use of Water

PURSUANT to the Electricity Act 1968, the Minister of Electricity hereby consents to the generation of electricity by James Macaulay and Ellen Daphne Macaulay, farmers, of French Pass, by the use of water, subject to the following conditions.

CONDITIONS

- 1. The conditions directed by the Water Power Regulations 1934 to be implied in every licence to use water for the purpose of generating or storing electricity shall be deemed to be conditions of this consent as if it were such a licence.
