PURSUANT to the Local Authorities Loans Act 1956, the Whangarei County Council hereby resolves as follows:

That, for the purpose of providing the annual charges on a loan of \$13,000 authorised to be raised by the Whangarei County Council under the above-mentioned Act for the purpose of purchasing a new fire appliance for the Portland Fire Brigade, the Whangarei County Council hereby makes a special rate of 0.00893c in the dollar upon the rateable value of all rateable property in the County of Whangarei; and that the special rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of the loan and be payable half-yearly on the 1st day of April and the 1st day of October in each and every year during the currency of the loan, being a period of 15 years, or until the loan is fully paid off.

Waipaoa River Flood Control Scheme Redemption Loan 1969, \$36,400

CENTRAL WAIKATO ELECTRIC-POWER BOARD

RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE

General Reticulation Loan (1969), \$800,000

PURSUANT to the Local Authorities Loans Act 1956, the Central Waikato Electric-power Board hereby resolves as follows:
