Notice to Make Payment of Income Tax Under the Land and Income Tax Act 1954

PURSUANT to the Land and Income Tax Act 1954, the Commissioner of Inland Revenue hereby gives notice as follows:

Income tax payable for the year of assessment which commenced on the 1st day of April 1970 on income derived (or deemed to have been derived) during the income year which commenced on the 1st day of April 1969 by:

- (1) Every subsisting company* otherwise than as trustee or agent;
- (2) Every public authority otherwise than as trustee or agent;
- (3) Every Maori authority:

shall be due and payable in one sum on the 7th day of February 1971 at any office of the Inland Revenue Department or at any post office with savings bank facilities.
