Any person wishing to lodge an objection to the granting of these applications should do so in writing on or before 4 February 1971. Submissions should include a reference to the application number, Tariff item, and description of goods concerned, be addressed to the Comptroller of Customs, Private Bag, Wellington, and supported by information as to:

- The range of equivalent goods manufactured locally;
- The proportion of New Zealand and imported material used in manufacture;
- Present and potential output; and
- Details of factory cost in terms of materials, labour, overhead, etc.
