PURSUANT to the Public Works Act 1928, I, Sir Arthur Espie Porritt, Baronet, the Governor-General of New Zealand, hereby revoke the Proclamation dated 28 February 1962 and published in *Gazette*, 8 March 1962, Volume I, page 376, registered as Proclamation No. S. 229522, South Auckland Land Desistered as Proclamation No. S. 229522, South Auckland Land Registry, taking an easement over land for the purposes of a Maori school, such easement being no longer required.
