PURSUANT to the Public Works Act 1928, I, Sir Arthur Espie Porritt, Baronet, the Governor-General of New Zealand, hereby proclaim and declare that the land described in the Schedule hereto is hereby taken for road; and I also declare that this Proclamation shall take effect on and after the 27th day of December 1971.

A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS the land described in the Schedule hereto was taken for the purposes of carsheds in connection with the electric tramways and vested in the Mayor, Councillors, and Citizens of the City of Wellington by a Proclamation dated the 16th day of August 1912 and published in *Gazette*, 22 August 1912, Volume II at page 2540.

Now therefore, pursuant to section 20 of the Public Works Amendment Act 1952, I, Sir Arthur Espie Porritt, Baronet, the Governor-General of New Zealand, hereby proclaim and declare that the said land is hereby set apart, as from the 27th day of December 1971, for housing purposes.
