- (a) One member appointed by the Christchurch City Council:
- (b) One member appointed by the Canterbury branch of the New Zealand Institute of Architects;
- (c) One member appointed by the Canterbury branch of the New Zealand Institution of Engineers;
- (d) Four members elected by the associations of employees in local industries;
- (e) Four members elected by the associations of employers in local industries;
- (f) One member appointed by the Council of the University of Canterbury;
- (g) One member appointed by the Canterbury Chamber of Commerce; and
- (h) Four members co-opted by the Board itself, one of whom is to be a woman at any time while there is no other woman member of the Board.
- 4. (1) Subject to the provisions of this clause, the members of the Christchurch Technical Institute Board of Governors shall hold office for a term of 3 years, but may from time to time be reappointed or re-elected.
- (2) Except in the case of a casual vacancy, every member shall hold office until the 31st day of March in the third year after the year of his appointment or election, and if on the 31st day of March the appointment or election of his successor has not been notified to the Board, he shall continue to hold office until the date on which that appointment or election is notified.
