And whereas, after due inquiry the Governor-General is of the opinion that the petition should be granted:

Now, therefore, I, Sir Arthur Espie Porritt, Baronet, the Governor-General of New Zealand, in pursuance and exercise of the power and authority conferred by section 3 of the Electric Power Boards Act 1925, and of every other power and authority in anywise enabling me in this behalf, do hereby alter the boundaries of the Amethyst Electric Power District so that is the cross described in the Schedule heresto. as to include therein the area described in the Schedule hereto.

SCHEDULE

PURSUANT to the Agricultural Pests Destruction Act 1967, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. (1) This order may be cited as the Waipa Pest Destruction District Constitution Order 1971.

(2) This order shall come into force on the 1st day of April

1971

2. There is hereby constituted a pest destruction district to be known as the Waipa Pest Destruction District, having as its boundaries that area specified in the Schedule hereto.

SCHEDULE

BOUNDARIES OF WAIPA PEST DESTRUCTION DISTRICT

ALL that area in the South Auckland Land District, Waipa County, containing 240,000 acres, more or less, bounded by a line commencing at a point in the middle of the Waipa River, in Block VII, Alexandra Survey District, in line with the production westerly of the northern boundary of Allotment 407, Tuhikaramea Parish; thence easterly along a right line, to and along the northern boundaries of Allotments 407 and 408,
