Declaring an Area in the Mangonui-Whangaroa Acclimatisation
District to be a Wildlife Refuge

ARTHUR PORRITT, Governor-General A PROCLAMATION

PURSUANT to section 14 of the Wildlife Act 1953, I, Sir Arthur Espie Porritt, Baronet, the Governor-General of New Zealand, hereby proclaim as follows:

- 1. (i) This Proclamation may be cited as the Kowhai Beach Wildlife Refuge Declaration.
- (ii) This Proclamation shall come into force on the day after the date of its notification in the Gazette.
- 2. The area described in the Schedule to this Proclamation is hereby declared to be a wildlife refuge for the purposes of section 14 of the Wildlife Act 1953.

NORTH AUCKLAND LAND DISTRICT—MANGONUI COUNTY PART Houhora Block situated in Blocks VII and XI, Houhora Survey District: area, 158 acres, more or less. Part certificate of title, Volume 2a, folio 219. (S.O. Plan 46631.) As the same is shown on plan marked I.A. Wil. 34/8/2 deposited in the Head Office, Department of Internal Affairs, Wellington, and thereon edged red.
