AN ACT TO AMEND THE CHRISTCHURCH GAS ACT 1870

AN ACT TO AMEND THE CHRISTCHURCH GAS ACT 1870 NOTICE is hereby given that THE CHRISTCHURCH GAS, COAL AND COKE COMPANY LIMITED (hereinafter called "the company") intends to apply for leave to bring into the House of Repre-sentatives during the present session of Parliament a Private Bill the short title of which is "The Christchurch Gas Amend-ment Act 1971".
