PURSUANT to section 12 of the Wool Industry Act 1944, the New Zealand Wool Board hereby fixes the following rates of the levy to be charged on all wool which, on and after the 1st day of July 1971 is exported from New Zealand or is delivered to a wool manufacturer for use in New Zealand.

On each kilogram greasy weight of all shorn wool and on each kilogram of staple wool, 1.55 cents.

This notice is to give effect to the conversion from the imperial to the metric system of weights.
